Tournament Rules!

Each week all grades will listen to the same three books in the tournament and vote for their favorite at the end of each week. The school's weekly overall favorites, The Final Three, will move on to "compete" against each other, with students voting for their favorite author/book to be the winner of March Reading Madness!

Weekly, you will receive an email with video links to each book. These books can be played for students when your schedule allows, as voting will take place on Thursdays.

During the last week of the tournament, March 20-24, revisit The Final Three books and have your class vote for the Arno National Book Champion on Thursday. The winner will be revealed on Friday, March 24.

We will put a blank book bracket in your mailbox. If you would like, you can copy a class set of the bracket and have your students track each week's winner or they can complete the bracket before the competition to predict the winner!

Lower grades could put the bracket on your board and circle the winners each week.


